-  **How do I apply for graduation?**

Applications are to be submitted to the Office of the Registrar no later than:
Fall: July 31, 2018
Spring: September 30, 2018
Summer: January 30, 2019
-  **What do I need to do to ensure I graduate in May?**
Make sure your graduation application is complete. Then, review your advising worksheet with your advisor to make sure you have met all necessary requirements.
-  **What is the difference between the Commencement Ceremony and the Graduate Degree Hooding Ceremony?**
Graduate Degree Hooding Ceremony – This ceremony is for individuals earning Graduate level degrees. The Dean of each Graduate program will place the hood on those earning Graduate level degrees. This ceremony replaces the traditional commencement ceremony in which undergraduates will attend.
- Commencement** – This ceremony is for individuals earning undergraduate level degrees. This ceremony is more traditional in nature, and the Dean of each program will present each graduate with a diploma cover.
-  **Who is eligible to participate in the Commencement Ceremony?**
All undergraduate degree candidates who received their degree as of Fall 2018, Spring 2019 or Summer 2019 are eligible to participate in the Commencement Ceremony.
-  **When will I receive my diploma?**
Upon completion of all degree requirements, diplomas will be mailed to the home address of the degree recipient within 4-6 weeks after graduation.
-  **Am I required to attend Commencement?**
All graduating undergraduate students are encouraged to attend, but attendance is not mandatory. The main objective of Commencement is to recognize those individuals who have dedicated their time and energy to achieving this award.
-  **How long is the Commencement Ceremony?**
The Commencement Ceremony should last approximately two (2) hours.

-  **Will there be an opportunity to mingle with family, friends and professors?**
Yes. There will be an opportunity to meet and greet with faculty immediately following the ceremony in the main entrance lobby at the HIGHMARK Gate. Please share this information with your family and friends.
-  **Is the venue for the Commencement Ceremony accessible to the disabled?**
Yes, all facilities in PPG Paints Arena are accessible to the disabled. Accessible seating is available on all seating levels. Volunteers will be available at the Check-in table to assist individuals in need. **It is strongly recommended that individuals with physical limitations bring their own wheelchair.**
-  **Do I need to notify anyone if I plan to attend the Commencement Ceremony?**
Yes, if you have sent in your application for graduation, received notification that you are eligible, and are planning to attend Commencement, you must RSVP online at [Commencement Registration](#). Deadline to RSVP is April 12, 2019.
-  **Is there a rehearsal?**
No, there will not be a rehearsal for this event.
-  **How will I know what to do when I arrive at the Commencement Ceremony?**
All students attending the ceremony should enter through the HIGHMARK gate at PPG Paints Arena and report to line-up by 12:00 pm. Further instructions will be given at that time. Please remember to bring your student calling card.
-  **Do I need to check-in upon arrival at the PPG Paints Arena?**
Students are to report to registration on the Main Floor of PPG Paints Arena and proceed to the Lower Level by 12:00 pm for line-up. A volunteer will direct you to the appropriate line. You **must** bring your student calling card.
-  **Where may I find more information about Commencement Honors, such as "Summa Cum Laude", "Magna Cum Laude", "Cum Laude", etc.?**
These terms are defined on page 54 of the undergraduate catalog under Recognition of Academic Achievement.
-  **Where may my family and I park?**
Parking will be available at the North/South Lot as well as the PPG Paints garage for a fee of \$6.50 per car. Other surrounding lots may be available. Valid disabled parking place cards are required. Accessible space is limited and an early arrival is strongly recommended.

-  **What time will my family be able to enter PPG Paints Arena for the Commencement Ceremony?**
Seating will begin at 11:30am. Commencement Ceremony will begin promptly at 12:30 pm.
-  **Will there be vendors selling flowers?**
Yes. PPG Paints Arena will have a vendor selling flowers and gifts.
-  **How many family members and friends may attend?**
This free event is open to all family members and friends who would like to attend. Tickets are not required.
-  **May children attend Commencement?**
Yes, children are welcome to attend the Ceremony. Child care is not available at the ceremony facilities. Children should be cared for by family members during the ceremony.
-  **Where can I purchase my cap and gown?**
Caps and gowns (and hood if applicable) will be available for purchase at the Graduation Fair at Point Park University. **All orders must be received by April 12, 2019.** If you are unable to attend the Graduation Fair, please visit the Point Park University Bookstore in order to purchase the cap and gown. It is your responsibility to bring your cap and gown with you to Commencement.
-  **Must I wear a cap and gown?**
Yes, participation in the Commencement Ceremony requires that you wear the traditional cap and gown, appropriate academic attire. The University will not provide robes for those who forget to bring their own.
-  **What should I wear to the Commencement Ceremony?**
This is a professional environment, business or dress clothes and shoes are required.
-  **On which side of my cap do I wear my tassel?**
Before candidates receive their degrees, the tassel is worn on the right side of the cap. After conferral of the degree, the tassel is moved to the left side.
-  **Can my family take pictures during the ceremony?**
Yes, it is encouraged.
-  **Will I have my photograph taken by a professional photographer at the Commencement Ceremony?**
Yes. GradTrak Graduate Images will be photographing each graduate as he/she crosses the stage at the Ceremony. You will be contacted by GradTrak Graduate Images via mail/email directly. There is a no obligation to purchase any photographs.



FAQs:

-  **I won't be attending Commencement. How will I get my diploma?**
All students that apply for graduation regardless of attendance at the ceremony will be reviewed for earning graduation requirements. Diplomas will be sent to the permanent address of the graduating student 4-6 weeks after graduation.
